Representatives Rich Vial and Ron Noble to Hold a Pre-Session Town Hall Meeting

SALEM, OR — Representatives Rich Vial and Ron Noble will hold a Town Hall meeting to provide a presession legislative update. The meeting will review issues relating to the 2017 Regular Session, including the transportation package and Measure 101, as well as legislation that both representatives hope to introduce during the 2018 Short Session. Constituents will also be able to ask the representatives questions and share their thoughts and concerns.
